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<p>I believe that the course was extremely important to learn how to use SPSS and especially to choose the appropriate statistical tests and use them properly in SPSS. It would be very useful if a new advanced SPSS course was offered. Should there be one, I would like to learn how to make multiple regressions, calculate samples and construct ROC curves.</p>

<p>It would be very interesting and useful if there was a statistics course that was a bit more theoretical but equally with a practical component to address the technical calculation of n, survival tests, etc. Using medical cases that make clinical sense would be good, but not essential. The course structure is very good, with only 2 classroom sessions and the remaining at home, thus allowing the combination of training with professional activities!</p>

Unfortunately, the course was held at the end of a semester of work and projects that had to be submitted, which prevented me from giving it my full attention.</p>

I also propose setting an exclusively morning or afternoon schedule in order to better adjust to the schedule of the face-to-face sessions and the more practical exercises, which are vital for the implementation of contents.
